NEW - Just a two-minute walk from THE PIG in the Cotswolds and The Village Pub, Home Farm House is a beautifully restored three-bedroom cottage that gives you the freedom of a private stay with the benefit of a hotel and pub on your doorstep. Full of quirks and character, guests will find a proper farmhouse kitchen, cosy sitting room, dining room - complete with wood burner - and even a games room for rainy-day fun. Upstairs, the master bedroom has its own en-suite bathroom with two further bedrooms which can be set up as king or twin, depending on who's coming along. They share a family bathroom and of course a beautiful view across the Cotswolds countryside.



Just a stone's throw from Home Farm House is **The Village Pub** which oozes English country charm, where the beauty of this place is in its simplicity. With crackling fires throughout the autumn and winter, and a menu brimming with nostalgic classics using the freshest and most flavorsome ingredients, this really is the perfect way to while away the afternoon or evening. Bring on Steak & Ale Pie or Bangers & Mash with onion gravy; Smoked Haddock Fish Cake or The Village Pub Ploughmans with Smarts Double Gloucester, Smoked Ham, a Pork Pie and the rest... And with a serious wine list to match plus soothing pints of local gravity fed ale from both Stroud and Arkells alongside others on tap like Severn Cider. But it's not just about the food and drink - The Village Pub is at the heart of the community, where the warmth and passion of the team makes every visit feel like coming home.

And a bit further down the road guests will find **THE PIG-in the Cotswolds**, a honey-hued 17th century Grade II gem, with original listed gardens designed by renowned gardener Rosemary Verey. With its cosy sitting rooms, House of Hackney wallpapered bar and cosy, vibrant restaurant, this is the perfect place for Home Farm House guests to head for a delicious 25-mile menu for which THE PIGS are so renowned. Think Woodchester Pot Roast Chicken with a Wild Mushroom Sauce & Chips or Gloucester Old Spot Pork Chop with Garden Greens & Mustard Sauce. For pud, Cotswold Dairy Cheesecake with Roasted Gooseberries or Roasted Victoria Plums with Plum & Thyme Sorbet should more than satisfy those with a sweet tooth.

A night at Home Farm House costs from £715 per night including breakfast with a two-night minimum stay requirement. Lunch or supper bookings at The Village Pub and THE PIG-in the Cotswolds can be made separately. Home Farm House includes:-

NOTES TO EDITORS

The Village Pub is a first for THE PIG group – a Grade II listed, 19th century classic British pub rooted in the heart of Barnsley, just four miles from the market town of Cirencester, and in perfect striking distance of Bibury, Burford and Bourton-on-the-water. The traditional Cotswold-stone building started life as 3 cottages which were converted in the early 18th century into The Greyhound Inn. The first registered owner was Wenman Aubrey Wykeham-Musgrave of Thame Park and Barnsley Park, until ownership passed to the Cirencester Brewery on 6th September 1935. In the 1920s, the pub changed its name to The Village Inn and, in 1952, it became Grade II listed. Around half a century later, The Village Inn swapped “inn” for “pub”, and after a brief 2-year stint as The Boot, it reopened in the summer of 2024 as The Village Pub – where the focus is on the humble list of proper pub food and traditional bar snacks on the menu, and local gravity fed ales and a serious wine list behind the bar. The Village Pub is quite different from what you’re used to seeing across THE PIGs, with its oak-beamed ceilings, large roaring fireplaces and 6 comfortable and stylish bedrooms tucked away in the eaves. While you won’t find a Kitchen Garden or Potting Shed treatment rooms at The Village Pub, you can be sure of the same reliable and honest commitment from THE PIG group in using the best quality local produce, and delivering a laid-back, warm and welcoming experience. The Village Pub aims to be the beating heart of the local community, where you will always see friendly, regular faces gathered at the bar and where you will always receive a warm welcome from the Pub Landlord Luis, every day of the week.

THE PIG group is a personal collection of small lifestyle restaurants with rooms where the focus is on authenticity and informality of design, food and service. There are currently nine PIG hotels; THE PIG, THE PIG-near Bath, THE PIG-on the beach; THE PIG-at Combe, THE PIG-in the wall, THE PIG-at Bridge Place, THE PIG-at Harlyn Bay, THE PIG-in the South Downs and THE PIG-in the Cotswolds. THE PIG hotels aim to deliver an outstanding experience for every guest; a 'wow' moment that surprises and delights for a price that won't break the bank.
