

Brewery Lane

Back of The PIG Walk
(approx. 30 minutes)



This walk will take you round the back of The PIG-at Bridge Place property following the Nail Bourne for a short while. The walk is very flat and is generally dry underfoot (unless we've had some rainy weather!) This walk is perfect for those needing a little wonder and fresh air for approximately 30 minutes.

DIRECTIONS

1. As you exit the main gate of the hotel, turn left and head straight down a wooded footpath on your left-hand side.
2. Follow this path all the way through the church yard until you come out onto Bridge High Street.
3. Turn left out of the church yard, pass The Red Lion pub, and take the first left onto Brewery Lane.
4. Amble down this road (past our very own Romney Marsh sheep) until you get to a turn in the road to the right.
5. Walk through the metal kissing gate on the corner of the road.
6. Following the footpath along the Nail Borne River for approximately 10 minutes (you will have to pass through a rickety old wooden gate as well!)
7. You'll be able to see some of the lovely PIG Main House from this path and also gain a good view of our Hop Pickers Huts.
8. At the end of the path, you'll reach another metal kissing gate – turn left once you have exited this field and head up towards the two terraced houses on Bourne Park Road.
9. From this point you can turn left and be back at The PIG in less than 5 minutes – or you can venture onwards!
10. You can explore the fields of Bourne Park House by heading right along the road (and maybe end up at Gilda's for cruffin or The Mermaid Inn for a pint of local ale).
11. Or, for a shorter extension – turn right and then directly left into the woodland and find your self in a lovely big field. Walk to the top and enjoy the best views Bridge has to offer!
